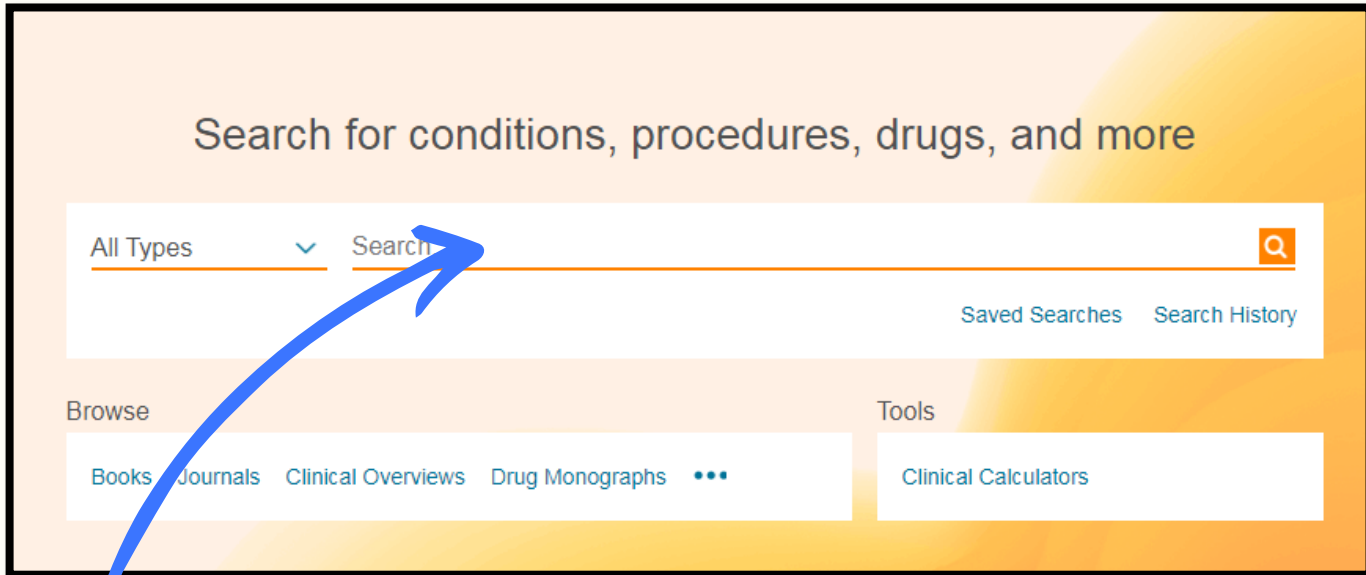


Enhanced Search

1. Visit ClinicalKey at www.clinicalkey.com and input a keyword into the search bar.

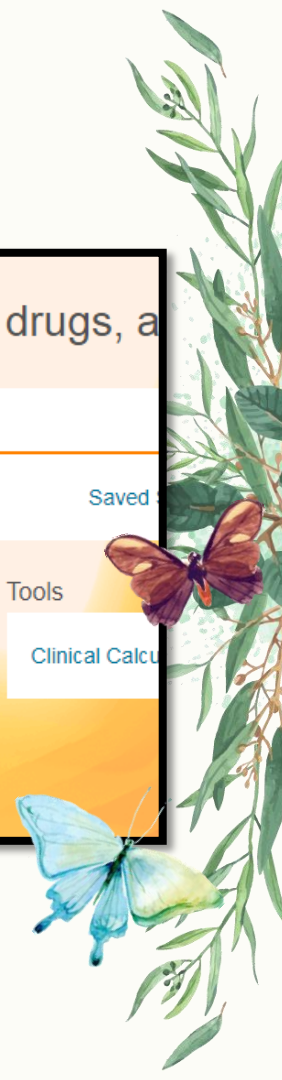
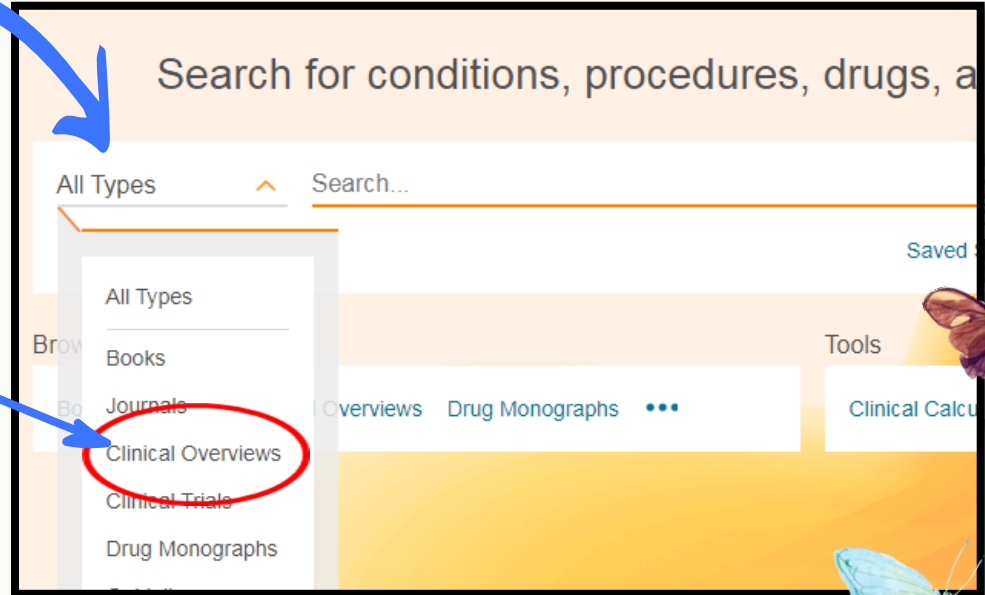

2. Optional: Select a **Source Type** by clicking on the drop-down menu, next to your search.

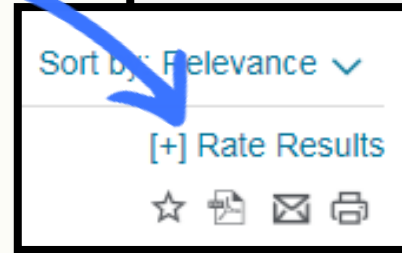
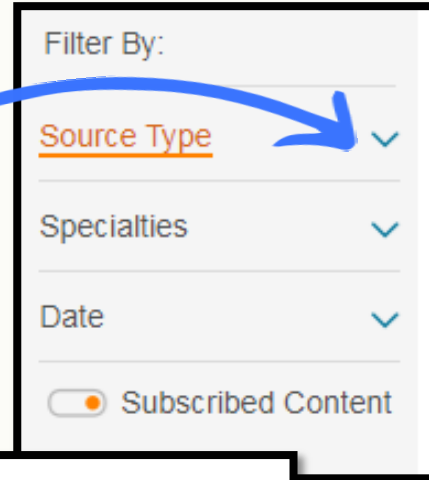
(**To generate disease and condition summaries, choose **Clinical Overviews**)

2. Rate Your Search to provide feedback on content discoverability

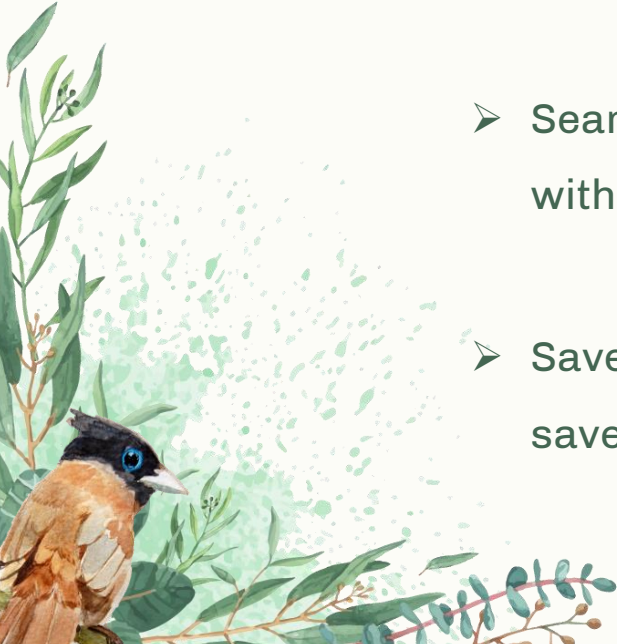


Filters and Sorting

A Personal account provides access to:

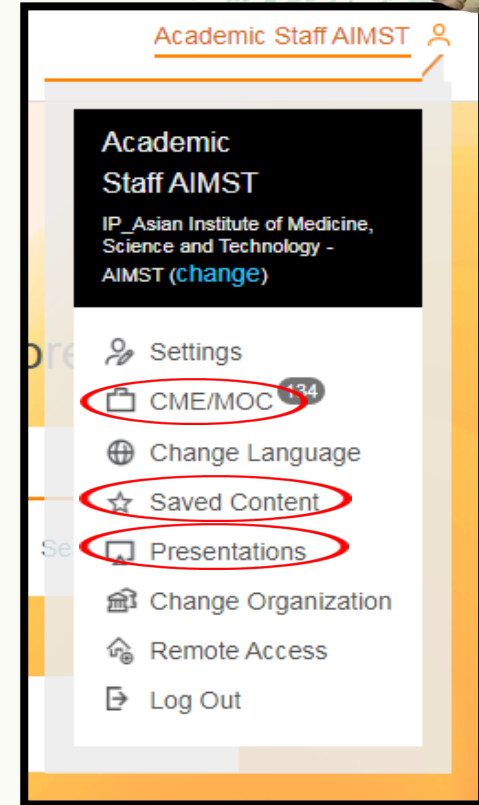

- Saved Searches: Click in your ★ Search History to save a search.



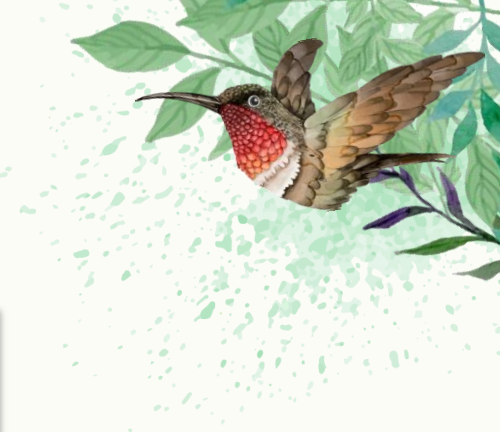

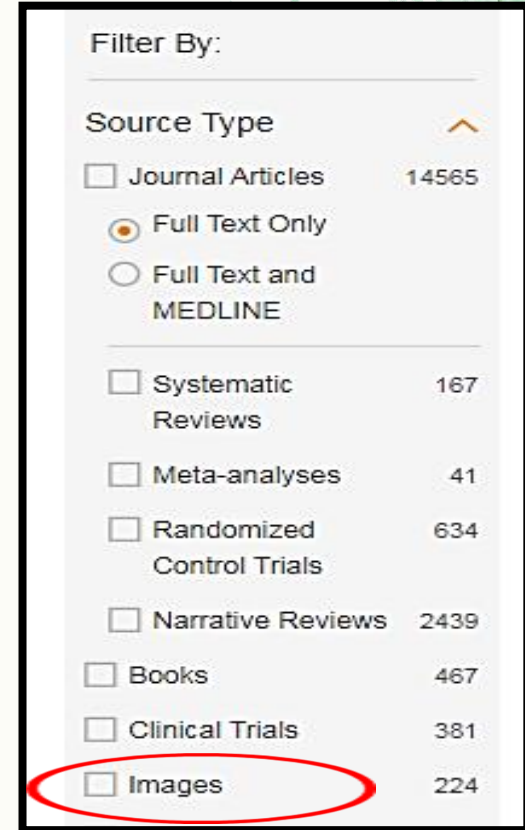
Presentation Maker

Images found in Clinicalkey can be added to PowerPoint through the Presentation Maker. The instructions below show how to create custom presentations through a personal account

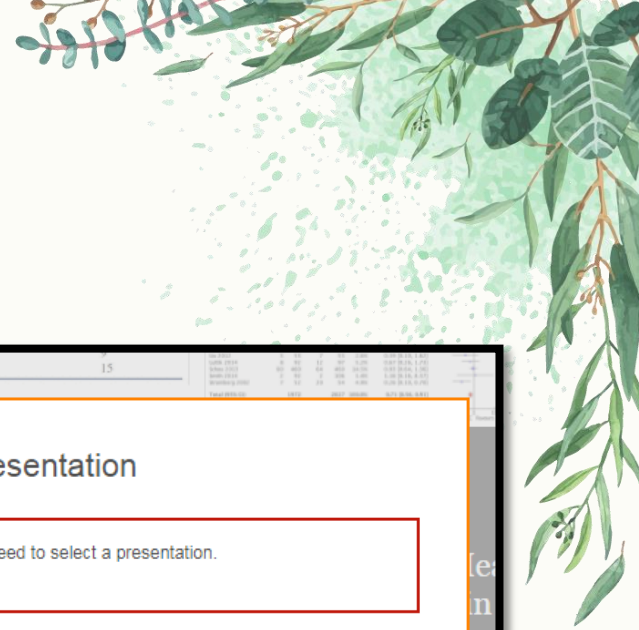



Create Presentations

1. Register or Login Clinicalkey.

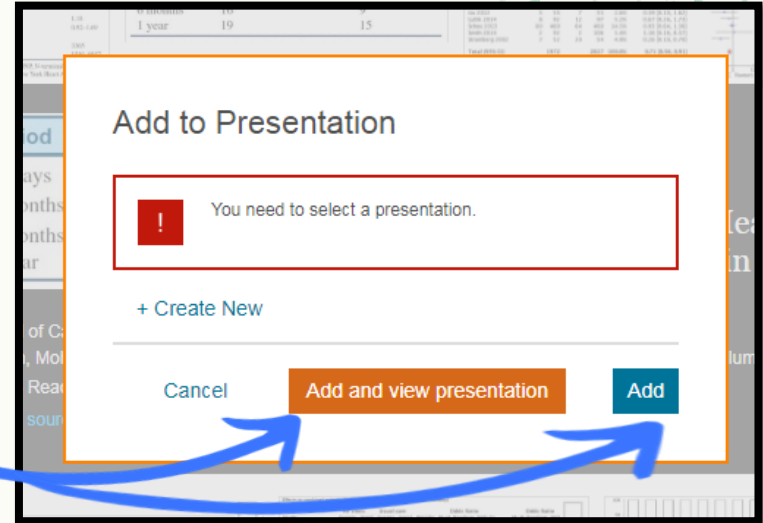

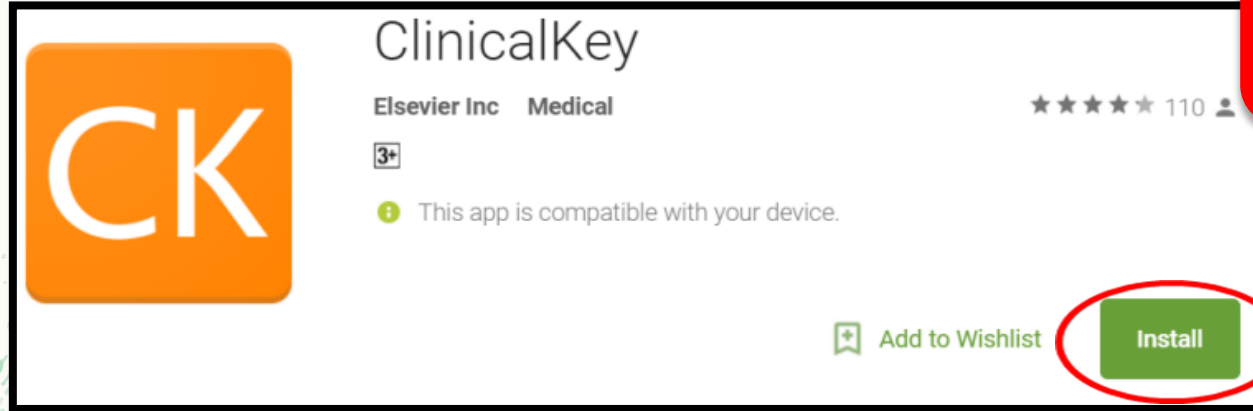


5. Visit Presentations by selecting **Presentations** from the login menu, accessible by clicking icon in the right-hand corner of the screen.
